Wexford County Council Climate Action Plan 2024 - 2029

Wexford County Council has prepared a Climate Action Plan (CAP) for the years 2024 - 2029 under Section 16 of the Climate Action and Low Carbon Development (Amendment) Act 2021.

The CAP was subject to Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) under SEA Directive 2001/42/EC as transposed into Irish law under the European Communities (Environmental Assessment of Certain Plans and Programmes) Regulations 2004 (S.I. 435/2004), as amended; and Appropriate Assessment (AA) the EU's Habitats Directive 92/43/EEC, as transposed into Irish law under Regulation 42(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 (S.I. No. 477/2011), as amended.


