7. CONSIDER MOTION SUBMITTED BY CLLR. TOM FORDE

"This council notes with serious concern the ongoing sewage leak in the Maudlintown area and the resulting environmental, public health and amenity impacts on local residents; and further calls on Uisce Éireann to urgently address this sewage leak as a matter of priority.

We ask Uisce Éireann to expedite and prioritise the necessary capital investment and infrastructure upgrades in the area to ensure a long-term and sustainable solution to this issue and to prevent any recurrence and that Uisce Éireann attend a meeting of our district council to discuss their investment plans in the district".

8. CONSIDER MOTION SUBMITTED BY CLLR. TOM FORDE

"I ask that this council identify suitable lands and deliver an allotment project within the district, potentially delivered in partnership with community groups or schools.

This would be in alignment with national policy where under the Planning and Development Act 2024, Local authorities are now required to prepare and include within their statutory development plans, a strategy for the reservation, provision, improvement and preservation of land for community gardens and allotments".
