13. Notices of Motion

13.1 Motion proposed by Cllr. Raymond Shannon and passed at the Wexford Borough District Meeting and requested to be forwarded to the full Council.

“That Wexford County Council call upon the Minister for Health & Minister for Mental Health that they include outsourcing assessment for CAHMS and after-care services be covered under a Patient Purchase Scheme after a three month waiting period.”

13.2 Motion passed at Rosslare Municipal District Meeting and requested to be forwarded to the full Council.

"The members of the Rosslare Municipal District ask that IPB funding which is matched by WCC be allocated to 100 €1000 grants. To be allocated equally across the five districts. We so propose. Cllr Carthy, Cllr Codd, Cllr Staples, Cllr McDonald and Cllr O' Brien."

13.3 Cllr. T. Forde & Cllr. A.R. O'Brien

"We ask that Wexford County Council write to the Minister for Health and all Irish MEPs to seek a pause on, and actively oppose, the proposed EU harmonisation of Maximum Permitted Levels for vitamin and mineral food supplements. We further request that the Minister ensures that any future regulations take account of differing geographical needs (such as widespread Vitamin D deficiency in Ireland), protect consumer choice, and safeguard the viability of local health food businesses."

13.4 Cllrs. B.A. Murphy, P. Breen, D. Kenny

"That this Council calls on the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage, to ensure that local authorities remain in a position to prioritise those housing applicants on their own housing lists and who reside in their county of application, over those who live in other counties when allocating social housing, (excluding those suffering from domestic violence). This is sought in order to prevent a national based type of choice based letting where length of time on the list may favour applicants from other counties over those living within their county of application."

13.5 Cllr. M. Sheehan

"Recognising that workers are disadvantaged under the current Scheme of Letting Priorities and National Income Guidelines, this Council resolves to call on the Minister for Local Government, Environment and Heritage to scrap the income guidelines and replace them with the same bands as Council Mortgages (€80k and €85k) to allow workers a better chance of entering the social housing support process."

13.6 Cllr. T. Forde

"That Wexford County Council recognizes the historical significance of the Spanish Civil War (1936–1939) and the profound impact it had on communities across Ireland.

This Council notes that approximately one dozen men from County Wexford travelled abroad to take part in this conflict, including notable figures such as Commander Peter Daly who made the ultimate sacrifice at the Battle of Belchite.

Acknowledging our shared duty to historical accuracy and local heritage, this Council agrees to coordinate a commemorative, community-led reflection event—leveraging funds such as the Wexford County Council Commemoration Scheme."
