Foreword

RÉAMH RÁ

Wexford is a unique and creative county with a rich cultural heritage. County Wexford is known for its Opera Festival, its world-renowned writers, its creative thinkers, its new generation of designers and its community of talented artists, musicians and performers. Wexford is a county that celebrates its heritage from the Viking and Norman periods to the rebel spirit of 1798 and 1916.

Wexford County Council warmly welcomes the ambitions of the Creative Ireland Programme, the Government's Legacy Programme for Ireland 2016 - a five-year initiative, 2017 to 2022, which places creativity at the centre of public policy. This high-level, ambitious government initiative aims to mainstream creativity in the life of the nation and ensure that individuals and communities are supported to further develop talents, creative enterprises, cultural infrastructure and experiences.

Is contae é Loch Garman ina ndéantar ceiliúradh ar a oidhreacht, mar shampla, tréimhsí na Lochlannach agus na Normannach agus meon reibiliúnach na mblianta 1798 agus 1916.

Cuireann Comhairle Chontae Loch Garman fáilte chroíúil roimh uaillmhianta Chlár Éire Ildánach, is é sin, an tionscnamh de chuid an Rialtais a eascraíonn le hoidhreacht ó Éire 2016 - tionscnamh cùig bliana, ó 2017 go 2022, trína gcuirtear an chruthaitheacht i gcroílár an bheartais phoiblí. Tá sé mar aidhm ag an tionscnamh ardleibhéal uaillmhianach seo de chuid an rialtais an chruthaitheacht a phríomhshruthú i saol an náisiúin agus a chinntíú go bhfaigheann daoine aonair agus pobail tacaíocht chun cumas, fiontair chruthaitheacha, infreastreachtúir chultúir agus eispéiris a fhorbairt tuilleadh.

The Creative Ireland Programme

CLÁR ÉIRE ILDÁNACH

The Creative Ireland Programme is the Government's Legacy Programme for Ireland 2016 – a five-year initiative, from 2017 to 2022, which places creativity at the centre of public policy. It is a high-level, high-ambition, all-of-government initiative to mainstream creativity in the life of the nation so that individually and collectively, in our personal lives and in our institutions, we can realise our full creative potential.

The Creative Ireland Programme is a culture-based programme designed to promote individual, community and national wellbeing. The core proposition is that participation in cultural activity drives personal and collective creativity, with significant implications for individual and societal wellbeing and achievement.

The Creative Ireland Programme is also the main implementation vehicle for the priorities identified in the Government's policy document, Culture 2025 – Éire Ildánach which states that arts and culture are intrinsic to the Irish State, acknowledges the need to increase access to, and participation in the arts, boost our creative industries, and preserve our heritage with a particular focus on language, landscape and the environment.

Is é Clár Éire Ildánach Clár Oidhreachta an Rialtais d'Éire 2016 – tionscnamh chuíg bliana idir 2017 agus 2022 ina leagtar béim ar an gcruthaitheacht ag croílár an bheartais phoiblí. Is tionscnamh ardleibhéal ard-uaillmhianach lánrialtais é chun an chruthaitheacht a phriomhshorthú i saol an náisiúin ionas gur féidir linne, inár n-aonar agus i gcomhar a chéile, inár mbeatha phearsanta agus inár geuid institiúidí, ár gcumas cruthaitheach iomlán a ráedú.

Is clár cultúr-bhunaithe é Clár Éire Ildánach atá deartha chun an fholláine aonair, pobail agus náisiúnta a chur chun cinn. Is é croílár an togra ná gurb é an rannpháirteachas sa ghníomhaíocht chultúrtha a threoraíonn an chruthaitheacht phearsanta agus chomhchoiteann, le himpleachtaí móra don fholláine agus don ghnóthachan aonair agus sochaíoch.

Is ionann an Clár agus an phríomhfheithicil fhorfheidhmithe freisin do na tosaíochtaí a ithníodh i gcáipéis bheartais an Rialtais Cultúr 2025 – Éire Ildánach, ina sloinntear gurb iad na healaíona agus an cultúr ina sainchodanna de Stát na hÉireann, agus ina n-aithnítear an gá chun: rochtain agus rannpháirteachas a mhéadú sna healaíona; borradh a thabhairt dár dtionscail chruthaitheacha; ár n-oidhreacht a chaomhnú le béim faoi leith ar an teanga, an tírdhreach agus an timpeallacht.

The programme is built around the themes of identity, culture and citizenship. The core operating principles are Collaboration and Communication, Community Empowerment, and Internationalisation.

Local authorities have a crucial role in the overall local delivery of the entire Creative Ireland Programme and are exclusively mandated, through their culture teams, to deliver Pillar 2 of the programme – Enabling Creativity in Every Community. This devolution of responsibility for Creative Ireland to local authorities is inspired by the extraordinary impact of collaborative local authority co-ordinated projects for the centenary of 1916. This Plan sets out the beginning of Wexford's part in this five-year journey, a truly important national policy initiative centred on culture and wellbeing.

The delivery of accessible high quality cultural experiences at local level is a key priority of the Wexford Creative Ireland Programme 2017. Wexford County Council seeks to encourage growth and realise the potential and sustainability of the arts and cultural sector while also preserving and promoting our rich cultural heritage.

Wexford County Council looks forward to working with the Creative Ireland Programme and engaging with local communities in developing the County Wexford Cultural and Creative Plan 2017-2022.

Leagtar amach sa Phlean tú le cuid Chill Dara san aistear chuíg bliana sin, ar tionscnamh fiorthábhachtach don bheartas náisiúnta é lena gcuirfear leis an gcultúr agus leis an bhfolláine go háitiúil.

Tugtar léargas sa cháipéis seo ar na gníomhaíochtaí atá ar siúl agus i mbéal forbartha i láthair na huairé lena mbaineann comhbainteanna leis na mianta agus leis na beartais atá taobh thiar d'Éire Ildánach 2017 – 2022. Is sála air seo a ullmhófar Plean Cultúir don Iarmhí 2018 – 2022 dá fhoilsíú i bhFómhar na bliana 2017.

TIONSCADAIL DON BHLIAIN 2017

The following are the projects/ initiatives to be delivered/ initiated in County Wexford in 2017 using the Creative Ireland Programme funds:

Cruinníú na Cásca, Easter Sunday

Based in two locations - Enniscorthy and Wexford Town - in 2017, Cruinníú na Cásca in County Wexford aimed to celebrate both our rich heritage and to provide a platform for the public to engage with the best of our contemporary artists, writers, storytellers and musicians.

Creative Ireland Grant Scheme 2017

The key objective of the scheme is to provide support to local communities to organise creative activities and projects that will encourage cultural participation. Successful applicants must demonstrate contribution towards the development of the Five Pillars of the Creative Ireland programme. It is expected that a wide range of community cultural initiatives will be supported in County Wexford in 2017.

Is iad seo a leanas na tionscadail/tionscnaimh a sholáthrófar/thionscnófar i gContae Loch Garman sa bhliain 2017 trí úsáid a bhaint as cistí Chlár Éire Ildánach:

Cruinníú na Cásca, Domhnach na Cásca

Bhí Cruinníú na Cásca lonnaithe in dhá ionad i gContae Loch Garman sa bhliain 2017 - Inis Córthaíd agus Baile Loch Garman - agus bhí sé mar aidhm aige ceiliúradh a dhéanamh ar ár n-oidhreacht shaibhir agus, chomh maith leis sin, deis a thabhairt don phobal dul i dteagmháil leis na healaíontóirí, na scríbhneoirí, na scéalaithe agus na ceoltóirí comhaimseartha is fearr dár gcuid.

Scéim Deontais Éire Ildánach 2017

Is é is príomhchuspóir don scéim ná tacaíocht a sholáthar do phobail áitiúla chun gníomhaíochtaí cruthaitheacha agus tionscadail chruthaitheacha, trína spreagfar rannpháirtíocht chultúir, a eagrú. Ní mór d'iarratasóirí a n-éiríonn leo a thaispeáint go mbeidh siad ag rannchuidiú le forbairt na gCúig Cholún de chuid chlár Éire Ildánach. Meastar go bhfaighidh raon leathan tionscnamh cultúir pobail tacaíochta i gContae Loch Garman sa bhliain 2017.

Living Arts – Art in Schools

The Creative Ireland Programme 2017 will allow for an extension of the highly successful Living Arts in Primary Schools programme run by Wexford County Council in partnership with Wexford Arts Centre. A team of artists provide children with understanding and experience of contemporary art-making in 4 primary schools per year - over 15 weeks. This extension will facilitate a pilot Living Arts programme in a 2nd level DEIS school targeting young people at risk of early school leaving. In addition, professional development for artists and teachers involved in the programme will include workshops by experts on VTS (Visual Thinking Strategies for children).

Film Wexford

Plans for a new website aimed at attracting film location companies, national and international, into County Wexford will be developed in 2017. The website will also be aimed at encouraging an indigenous film industry. This website will utilise the database of film locations, photographed and documented for Wexford County Council by a Film Location Manager in Spring 2017. Work on the new 'Film Wexford' website will begin in Oct 2017 with a view to launching the site in early 2018.

Na hEalaíona Beo - An Ealaín sna Scoileanna

Mar thoradh ar Chlár Éire Ildánach 2017 beifear in ann leathnú a dhéanamh ar an gclár thar a bheith rathúil dar teideal Ealaíona Beo i mBunscoileanna agus a réachtáil Comhairle Chontae Loch Garman i gcomhpháirtíocht le hIonad Ealaíon Loch Garman. É ascóidh an leathnú seo clár Ealaíon Beo i scoil DEIS 2ú leibhéil, ar clár é a bheidh thírithe ar dhaoine óga a bhfuil baol luathfhágála scoile ann ina leith. De bhréis air sin, áireoidh forbairt ghairmiúil d'ealaíontóirí agus do mhúinteoirí atá páirteach sa chlár ceardlanna a seolfaidh saineolaithe i réimse na Straitéisí Amharcsmaointeoireachta do leanáin).

Scannánaíocht Loch Garman

Déanfar pleannána le haghaidh láithreán gréasáin nua, a bheidh mar aidhm aige cuideachtaí láithreacha scannán, idir naísíonta agus idirnáisiúnta, a tharraingt chug Contae Loch Garman, a forbairt sa bhliain 2017. Beidh sé mar aidhm ag an láithreán gréasáin freisin spreagadh a thabhairt i leith tionscal dúchasach scannánaíochta. Bainfidh an láithreán gréasáin seo leas as an mbunachar sonraí láithreacha scannán a ndearna Bainisteoir Láithreacha Scannán grianghraifa a thógáil díobh, agus taifead a dhéanamh orthu, do Chomhairle Chontae Loch Garman in Earrach 2017. Cuirfear túis leis an láithreán gréasáin nua 'Film Wexford (Scannánaíocht Loch Garman)' i nDeireadh Fómhair 2017 d'fhonn an láithreán gréasáin nua ag túis na bliana 2018.

Professional Development for Artists

In partnership with Visual Artists Ireland and Wexford Local Enterprise Office, a series of workshops – on ‘Marketing , presenting , yourself as an artist’ and Selling your Art (a guide to navigating art galleries, public art institutions, art fairs, events) will be held in late 2017. These workshops will aim to encourage career pathways for artists in County Wexford.

New Ross - Graves & Co

This project will involve cataloguing and preparation for digitisation of an important collection of original documents relating to a prominent shipping company in New Ross. Graves & Co. were one of the main shipping companies that facilitated emigration from the ports of New Ross and Wexford to Savannah, Georgia in the 1840s-1860s. The collection mainly comprises correspondence (approx. 2,500 letters) covering the period c. 1855-75, many of which refer to families emigrating from Wexford. This project is part of the Wexford/Savannah Axis Research Project – a major new research and heritage initiative that was established in 2013 to chronicle the historic links between Savannah and County Wexford.

Forbairt Ghairmiúil d'Ealaontóiri

I gcomhpháirtíocht le hAmharcealaíona Éireann agus le hOifig Fointair Áitiúil Loch Garman, déanfar sraith ceardlann faoi ‘Tú féin a Mhargadh agus a Chur i Láthair mar Ealaontóir’ agus ‘Do Shaothar Ealaíne a Dhíol’ (treoir maidir le déileáil le gailearaithe ealaíne, le hinstítíúidí ealaíne poiblí, le haontaí ealaíne, le himeachtaí) a eagrú ag deireadh na bliana 2017. Beidh sé mar aidhm ag na ceardlanna sin conairí gairmréime a mholadh d'ealaontóiri i gContae Loch Garman.

Ros Mhic Thriúin – Graves & Co

Is é a bheidh i gceist leis an tionscadal seo ná bailiúchán tábhachtach de dhoiciméid bhunaidh a bhaineann le cuideachta loingseoireachta mór le rá i Ros Mhic Thriúin a chatalógú agus é a ullmhú lena dhigitíú. Bhí Graves & Co. i measc na bpriomhchuideachtaí loingseoireachta a d'éascaigh eisimirce ó chalafoirt Ros Mhic Thriúin agus Loch Garman go Savannah, Georgia, sa tréimhse ó bhlianta na 1840-aí go blianta na 1860-idí. Cuimsíonn an bailiúchán comhfheagras den chuid is mó (tuairim is 2,500 litir), is é sin le rá, comhfheagras ón tréimhse c. 1855-75 a mbaineann cuid mhór de le teaghlaigh a chuaigh ar an imirce ó Loch Garman. Tá an tionscadal seo ina chuid de Thionscadal Taighde Ais Loch Garman/Savannah, ar mórtionscnamh nua taighde agus oidhreachta é a bunaíodh sa bhliain 2013 chun taifeadadh a dhéanamh ar na naisc staire atá ann idir Savannah agus Contae Loch Garman.

Norman Way

The Norman Way/Norman Wexford has been created to place Wexford as the heart of Norman Ireland. The Norman Way raises awareness and education on the Norman way of life and allows the visitor to learn about the rich legacy through the outstanding medieval Norman Castles and Churches that are located throughout County Wexford. Funding will assist in creating awareness of Wexford's unique and important Norman history through various events including a launch with promotion booklets, lecture and discussion evenings with local people and businesses, a Norman Heritage School pack a heritage cycling tour and the development of Website and interpretation.

3D design, 3D printing and coding workshops

Exploiting the new 3D Creative Maker space in Wexford County Library, a series of workshops on design and creation using freely available software and the 3 D printer will be provided for young people and adults free of charge. Coding and robotic workshops will also be provided for children.

Slí na Normannach

Cruthaíodh Slí na Normannach/Loch Garman Normannach chun Loch Garman a bhunú mar lárphointe na hÉireann Normannaí. Cuireann Slí na Normannach le feasacht agus le hoideachas faoi thionchar shlí mhaireachtála na Normannach agus tugann sé deis do chuaiteoirí chun foghlaim faoin oidhreacht shaibhir atá ann sna Caisleáin agus sna Teampailliointacha mheánaiseacha Normannacha atá suite ar fud Chontae Loch Garman. Cabhróidh an maoiniúchán le méadú na feasachta ar stair uathúil thábhachtach Loch Garman a mhéid a bhaineann le tréimhse na Normannach agus déanfar sin trí imeachtaí éagsúla a eagrú, lena n-áirítear lainseáil leabhrán poiblíochta, tráthnóna léachta agus diospóreachta le daoine agus gnóthaí áitiúla, pacá Oidhreachta Normannaí do Scoileanna, turas rotháiochta agus forbairt Láithreáin Gréasáin agus líirmhíniúcháin.
