<i>Fauscailt</i>	Eamonn O'Doherty	Outdoor Sculpture	Five larger than life bronze figures each holding an extended pike. A 1798 Commemorative Work of Art. Located at Larkin's Cross on the N25 Wexford to New Ross road. Associated Scheme: N25 Road Build
<i>Passage of Time</i>	Dan George	Outdoor Sculpture	Six double ring aluminium units. Fixed between the rings of each unit are images with coloured highway reflective sheeting. As viewers pass by the installation, seventy-five metres in length, the rings appear to move or shift in relationship to each other. These shifts create a cinematic unfolding of the imagery. The rings refer to the circular structure of earthworks, crop marks and Norman architecture found throughout the area. The shape and presence of the coloured imagery is derived from the area roadways as described on Ordnance Survey Map 36. Further incorporation of symbols includes the profile of pottery shards found during the road's excavation as well as other archaeological findings. <i>Untitled</i>	Anne Mulrooney	Visual Art (Photography and Sculpture)	Reservoir, Receiver and Rootcup are bronze and What Becomes of the Broken Hearted is a box with an internal grid constructed from found and recycled objects. Associated Scheme: Moin Rua, Monageer Enniscorthy
<i>It was a Wednesday Afternoon</i>	Declan Breen	Outdoor Sculpture	3 Stainless Steel stools with various toys and items of clothing/footwear in cast bronze. There is also a dog in bronze positioned by the stools. Associated Scheme: Millhaven, Castlebridge
<i>Taraxacum Officinale</i>	Lucy Hill	Outdoor Sculpture	Sculpture of an unopened Dandelion Flower. Associated Scheme: Drumgoold, Enniscorthy
<i>Angels of the Sea and Keepers of the Light</i>	Kathleen Delaney	Visual Art (Tapestry)	Angels of the Sea: The Artist designed and hand-printed each unique piece of fabric and used symbols to depict the underwater scene. This sumptuous wall-hanging in rich textiles with its shoal of angels/mermaids was created to honour the lives of those lost at sea. Inspiration for the painting 'Keepers of the Light' comes from the strong elemental forces to which the Hook Peninsula is exposed. The painting in four panels depicts the elements of earth, fire, water and air. Both pieces are located in Hook Lighthouse. Associated Scheme: Fethard-on-Sea Housing Scheme
<i>Seascapes</i>	Dorothy Heywood	Outdoor Mosaic	Series of mosaics sited in recessed areas in footpaths. Associated Scheme: St. Brendan's Estate, Rosslare Harbour
<i>Fair Gate Weavers, Gate and North Gate</i>	Seamus Dunbar	Outdoor Sculpture	3 pieces of outdoor sculpture inspired by New Ross's rich historical heritage as a walled town. As well as the much celebrated 3 Bullet Gate, the Artist was also inspired by Broguemaker's Gate and Weaver's Gate. Fair Gate, Weaver's Gate and North Gate symbolise this rich heritage of the past and link it to the residents of Cluain Húighéid. Associated

<i>Her Hair</i>	Michael Warren	Outdoor Sculpture	5 metres high, columnar shaped sculpture of cast, patented bronze on a landscaped mound. Located in the Gorey Forest Carpark in Courtown Harbour. Associated Scheme: Courtown / Riverchapel Main Drainage Scheme
<i>The Whisper of Ghosts</i>	Elaine Agnew	Music	A collaborative composition of an orchestral and choral work between Composer Elaine Agnew, writer Kate Newman, the pupils of Piercestown, Mayglass and Murrintown Primary Schools and the Piercestown Active Retirement Group.
