Pursuant to Part XI of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and in accordance with Part 8, Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), notice is hereby given that Wexford County Council proposes to carry out the development, particulars of which are set out hereunder.

The development of a public realm area in The High Hill in New Ross, to include:

- Norman Gardens
 - Create formal planting patterns consisting of a variety of hedges, aromatic plants and herbs.
 - A series of faceted gardens form the space between the paths and negotiate the topography
- Footpaths and pathways connecting the River Barrow to St Marys Church of Ireland
- Shared surfaces to improve pedestrian access and movement Public "resting" Nodes- incorporating seating
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Based on a preliminary examination of the nature, size and location of the development, there is no likelihood of significant effects on the environment and an Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) is not required.

Any person may, within 4 weeks from the date of the notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening

determination as to whether the development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.
