### Advice for the Prevention of Water Pollution from Agricultural Activities

Farmers and other users of pesticides are reminded to follow the Dept of Agriculture, Food and Marine, Pesticide Registration & Control Division advice for herbicide use;

- **Be especially cautious when using MCPA for rushes control**
- **Statutory safeguard zones from 5 to 200 metres exist about water abstraction points**

#### Remember

A single drop of herbicide can pollute a small stream for 30 km along its entire length.

## Roads

### Section 75 of Roads Act 1993 Temporary Closing of Roads

Notice is hereby given that Wexford County Council intends to close the following streets in Wexford Town on the dates set out below to facilitate proposed outdoor activities on Charlotte Street.

#### Road Closures

**Charlotte Street** (L7507-1), from its junction with Commercial Quay to its junction with North Main Street.

**Monck Street** (L7506-1), from its junction with Wellington Place to its junction with North Main Street. This street will be closed to facilitate proposed outdoor activities on Charlotte Street.

#### Dates and Times

Every Saturday and Sunday from 1 June to 1 September 2019 between 12.00 and 19.00.  
The road closures will be signposted. Local access will be facilitated.

Any person wishing to object to the closing of these roads should lodge the objection, in writing, to the County Secretary, Wexford County Council, before 12.00 noon on Monday 29 April 2019.

### Section 75 of Roads Act 1993 Temporary Closing of Roads

Wexford County Council has decided to close the road listed hereunder to vehicular traffic on Sunday, 28 April 2019 from 07.00 to 15.00, to facilitate the holding of a half marathon.

**Road Closure:** L3505-2 – The Faythe (Billy Kelly Pub side of the road ONLY), from the north west boundary wall of the Faythe Guest House to the start of the fork in the road opposite Mulligan's Funeral Home.

**Alternative Route:** From Faythe Lane to Kevin Barry Street to Parnell Street to Trinity Street to William Street to The Faythe to Faythe Lane.

Alternative routes will be signposted. Local access will be facilitated.
