Notice Under Section 177ae(4)(A) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as inserted by Section 57 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010

Ballywilliam Culvert Replacement

Application to An Bord Pleanála

Notice is hereby given that Wexford County Council intends to make an application for approval to An Bord Pleanála to carry out development which involves the replacement of culverts and all associated ancillary works at Ballywilliam Bridge and Aughnacrew Bridge in the village of Ballywilliam, Co. Wexford.

The proposed development consists of:

- The excavation of the existing roadway, and demolition and removal of existing pipe culverts from the Aughnacrew River at Ballywilliam Bridge and Aughnacrew Bridges;
- Installation of new box culverts, wingwalls and other supporting infrastructure at the bridges;
- Installation of rock armour to river banks;
- Installation of new parapets;
- Provision of new asphalt surfacing, footways and verges;
- Straightening of river bank near Ballywilliam bridge and provision of a sheet pile wall on downstream side; and
- All ancillary site development works.

In accordance with S177AE of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as inserted by S57 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act, 2010, Wexford County Council proposes to seek the approval of An Bord Pleanála for the proposed development.

A Natura Impact Statement has been prepared in respect of the proposed development.

An Bord Pleanála may give approval to the application for development with or without conditions or may refuse the application for development.

A copy of the plans and particulars of the proposed development and of the Natura Impact Statement may be inspected free of charge or purchased at the following locations at the specified times:

- New Ross Municipal Office, The Tholsel, New Ross, Co. Wexford, Y34 CF64

Between the hours of 9.00am to 1.00pm and 2.00pm to 5.00pm on Mondays to Fridays (public holidays excluded) from 1st February 2019 to 15th March 2019 inclusive of both dates.

The plans and particulars of the proposed development and the Natura Impact Statement may also be inspected free of charge or purchased at the offices of An Bord Pleanála, 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1 from 9.15am to 5.30pm Monday to Friday.

Submissions and observations are invited relating to –

- The implications of the proposed development for the proper planning and sustainable development of the area concerned,
- The likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, and
- The likely significant effects of the proposed development on a European site, if carried out.

Submissions and observations may be made in writing to An Bord Pleanála during the period:

1st February 2019 to 15th March 2019.

Any person may, within 4 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the development would have significant effects on the environment.
