Grants under the Community Enhancement Programme 2018

Wexford County Council Local Community Development Committee (LCDC) on behalf of the Department of Rural and Community Development invites applications for funding submissions under the Community Enhancement Programme 2018.

A total fund of €200,000 has been made available to support the development of Smart Villages through enhanced use of the local community centre. An additional fund of approximately €77,000 is also available to support small-scale capital projects within clearly identifiable Community Centres. The maximum grant available per project under each scheme is shown under – these limits may be exceeded in limited and confined circumstances. Match funding is not required. All projects should be delivered before **29th March, 2019**.

Scheme	Maximum Grant
Smart Village	€10,000
Community Centre	€3,000

Smart Villages refers to rural areas and communities which build on their existing strengths and assets as well as on developing new opportunities. In Smart Villages, traditional and new networks and services are enhanced by means of digital, telecommunication technologies, innovations and the better use of knowledge, for the benefit of inhabitants and businesses e.g. access to internet services to enable e-learning, enable access to on line services e.g. motor tax on line, revenue services, government returns etc. Funding will be made available to community centres within villages which meet the minimum standards as outlined in the scheme guidelines.

Examples of items eligible for funding under the Community Centres Scheme include kitchen equipment, indoor sports equipment, office furniture & equipment. Examples of items eligible for funding under the Smart Villages Scheme include IT equipment and internet access upgrade works.

Both schemes are available to locally-based community and voluntary groups. Commercial organisations, individuals and for-profit organisations are not eligible to apply.

Only capital projects are eligible. Funding cannot be provided towards any day-to-day expenses (i.e. current or operating costs) e.g. Routine maintenance, minor repairs or other on-going costs (for example, replacement of filters or light bulbs, painting, minor repair of components or items subject to wear and tear, etc.) Please see guidelines for further details of non-eligible items.

Temporary Closing of Roads**

Wexford County Council has decided to extend the road closure listed hereunder to vehicular traffic from Wednesday January 2 2019 to Friday February 1 2019, between 08.00 and 17.00 Monday to Friday, to facilitate the installation of water mains along this road.

Road Closure: L7047-2 Redshire Road (from its junction with the L3041 in Murntown Village to its junction with the L30441-1 at Staplestown)

Alternative Route: From Murntown Village to Gorteenminoge to Corramacorra to Staplestown via L3041, L3044 and L30441.

Timeframe may vary depending on progress and weather. Alternative routes will be signposted.
