### Grants under the Community Enhancement Programme 2019

Wexford County Council in conjunction with Wexford Local Community Development Committee (LCDC) on behalf of the Department of Rural and Community Development invites applications for funding submissions under the Community Enhancement Programme 2019.

A total fund of approximately €150,000 has been made available by Wexford LCDC to support small-scale capital projects, and is being distributed across the following two measures:

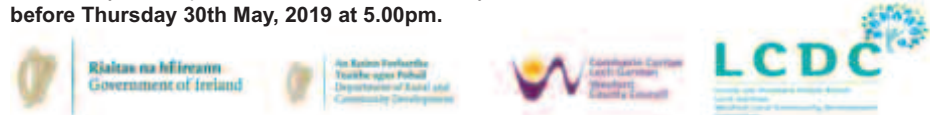
- Measure 1:** A total fund of €100,000 is available to support the enhancement of communities. This measure will offer grants up to a maximum of €1,000 per project.
- Measure 2:** An additional fund of approximately €50,000 is available to support climate change reduction and mitigation measures. This measure will offer grants up to a maximum of €3,000 per project.

Limits may be exceeded in limited and confined circumstances. Match funding is not required. All projects should be delivered in 2019.

The Programme is available to a wide range of organisations, including locally-based community and voluntary groups, together with Not-for-Profit organisations. Commercial organisations, individuals and for-profit organisations are not eligible to apply.

Only projects of a capital nature may be funded. Examples of eligible funding items include, for example, office equipment, community facilities, energy efficiency equipment, etc. Funding cannot be provided towards any day-to-day expenses e.g. routine maintenance, minor repairs or other on-going costs. ### **Wexford County Council Town and Village Renewal Scheme 2019**

#### **Expressions of Interest Invited**

The Town and Village Renewal Scheme 2019 has recently been launched with grants available for the renewal and redevelopment of rural towns and villages all across Ireland.

The Scheme is specifically targeted at rural towns and villages with populations of less than 10,000. Up to 80% of the total cost of a project will be provided for any individual project. Grants will range from €20,000 to a maximum of €100,000 per project while up to €200,000 can be considered for a limited number of projects which can demonstrate exceptionally strong benefit to a town and/or its outlying areas.

Wexford County Council invites Expressions of Interest from town/village groups who may have a suitable project for consideration under the Scheme.

All expressions of interest received will be assessed, following which a maximum of 12 proposals will be selected for development into detailed applications and submitted to the Department of Rural and Community Development for consideration under the Scheme.

## Roads

### Section 75 of Roads Act 1993 Temporary Closing of Roads

Notice is hereby given that Wexford County Council intends to close the road listed hereunder to vehicular traffic from Monday 17 June 2019 to Friday 9 August 2019, between 08:00hrs and 18:00hrs each day, to facilitate the installation of water mains.

**Road Closure:** L2045-5 from Ballyhogue crossroads to its junction with the Tinnakilla to Shanahona road

**Alternative Route:** From Tinnakilla to Shanahona to Ballyhogue via L20452, R730 and the L6081.

Timeframe may vary depending on progress and weather. Alternative routes will be signposted.

Local access to restricted areas will be facilitated. It is anticipated that the road will re-open to traffic at weekends and evenings.

Any person wishing to object to the closing of this road should lodge the objection, in writing, to the County Secretary before 12:00hrs on Monday 20 May 2019.

### Section 75 of Roads Act 1993 Temporary Closing of Roads

Notice is hereby given that Wexford County Council intends to close the road listed hereunder to vehicular traffic from Monday 17 June 2019 to Saturday 31 August 2019, to facilitate water main rehabilitation works.

**Road Closure:** R745-15 Upper Main Street Ferns from the Ferns Roundabout to its junction with the Carnew road (L1014)

**Alternative Route:** From the Ferns Roundabout to the Enniscorthy Road to the Ferns Castle to Upper Main Street via the N11, L5131 and the R745.

Alternative routes will be signposted. Local access will be facilitated.

Any person wishing to object to the closing of this road should lodge the objection, in writing, to the County Secretary before 12.00 noon on Monday 20 May 2019.

### Section 75 of Roads Act 1993 Temporary Closing of Roads

Wexford County Council has decided to close the road listed hereunder to vehicular traffic on Sunday 19 May 2019 from 08:00hrs to 18:00hrs, to facilitate the holding of the New Ross Aims Choral Festival.

**Road Closure:** South Street (L4500-3), New Ross, from its junction with Michael Street to its junction with Charles Street.

**Alternative Route:** From Charles Street to Mary Street to Barrack Lane to Michael Street to South Street

Alternative routes will be signposted. Local access will be facilitated.
