Notice of Proposed Development by a Local Authority**

Kilmore Quay, Co. Wexford**

Pursuant to Part XI of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and in accordance with Part 8, Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), notice is hereby given that Wexford County Council proposes to carry out the development, particulars of which are set out hereunder.

- The proposed development involves the construction of a new link road traversing parts of the town lands of Beak and Ballyteige at Kilmore Quay, linking the R739 Regional Road and the L3056 Local Primary Road, and thus reducing the volume of traffic through the centre of the village of Kilmore Quay.

Based on a preliminary examination of the nature, size and location of the development, there is no likelihood of significant effects on the environment and an Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) is not required.

Any person may, within 4 weeks from the date of the notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection, or purchase, at a reasonable fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, during office hours at the following location:

Wexford County Council (Segregation, Storage and Presentation of Household and Commercial Waste) Bye-Laws, 2018

Wexford County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Part 19 and Section 199 of the Local Government Act 2001, as supplemented by Section 35 of the Waste Management Act 1996, hereby gives notice of the making of new bye-laws to regulate and control the segregation, storage and presentation of household and commercial waste within its functional area.

There is provision within the Bye-Laws for the imposition of a fixed penalty payment of €75 in respect of a contravention of a Bye-Law as an alternative to a prosecution, as provided for in Section 206 of the Local Government Act, 2001.

The Bye-Laws will be available for public inspection during normal opening hours at Wexford County Council Offices at Carricklawn, Wexford and on the Council's website www.wexfordcoco.ie/waste-and-recycling. A copy of the Bye-Laws will be given to any such person requesting a copy, free of charge.
