Rehabilitation work to the Sli Charman Coastal Trail

Over the next two months Wexford County Council will undertake rehabilitation work to the Sli Charman Coastal Trail at four locations, Ballymoney Lower, Cahore Point, Blackwater to Knocknasillige and Rosslare Harbour. The Sli Charman Trail was developed in the early 90's but has been neglected for some time. The rehabilitation work will involve laying or re-laying gravel or macadam over the existing trails, erecting new signage, fencing and drainage.

The works has received support funding from the Department of Rural & Community Development under the 2018 Outdoor Recreational Infrastructure Scheme (ORIS). Details of the proposed work are available at: wexfordcoco.ie/community/recreational-and-community-development-projects

**Notice of the passing of a resolution to
vary the Rate of Local Property Tax**

**Section 75 of Roads Act 1993
Temporary Closing of Roads**

Wexford County Council has decided to close the road listed hereunder to vehicular traffic from Monday 30 September 2019 to Friday 4 October 2019, to facilitate installation of a cattle underpass.

Road Closure: L2037-1 at Coolaught, Clonroche, from its junction with the townland of Castleboro Demesne to its junction with the L40051 in the townland of Ballymackesy.

Alternative Route: From Coolaught to Castleboro Demesne to Townamulloge to Knockredmond to Moneytucker to Ballymackesy to Coolaught via the L6099, R730, N30 and the L40051.

Alternative routes will be signposted. Local access will be facilitated.

Call for Expressions of Interest for the Supply of Social Housing

Wexford County Council is currently prioritising housing programmes for delivery. As part of a range of housing solutions, the housing authority is currently seeking expressions of interest from private developers, building contractors and land owners.

Interested parties should be capable of delivering social housing units within the County and have serviced lands, housing proposals or turn key developments available.

Current housing demand is prioritised within the urban areas of Wexford and Gorey, Enniscorthy and New Ross but all proposals will be considered, including those proposals which address current demand in zoned areas.

In particular Wexford County Council is seeking in order of priority:-

- **Turnkey developments. Acquisitions are on a turnkey basis; potential payment is a fixed price lump sum, on completion of a development, within an agreed timeframe.**
- **Serviced land zoned for residential development.**
- **Mixed development schemes where social residential components could be incorporated into them.**

All developments and associated works must be fully compliant with the Department of Housing, Planning and Local Government guidelines and standards.
