**Wexford County Council (Segregation, Storage and Presentation of Household and Commercial) Bye-Laws 2018/
Fodhlíthe Chontae Loch Garman (Dramhaíl Teaghlaigh agus Tráchtála a Leithlisiú, a Stóráil agus a Thabhairt i Láthair), 2018**

Wexford County Council gives notice that it has adopted the above Bye-laws in accordance with Part 19 of the Local Government Act 2001 and Section 35 the Waste Management Act 1996 to provide for the manner and presentation of Kerbside Household and Commercial Waste for collection in Co. Wexford. The Bye-laws came in force on 2nd January, 2019.

Roads

Roadside Trees, Ditches and Hedges

Wexford County Council wishes to give notice that under the terms of the Roads Act, 1993, landowners and occupiers of land are obliged to take all reasonable care to ensure that the trees, ditches, hedges and all other vegetation growing on their land are not or could not become a danger to people using or working on a public road.

Examples of hazards might be dead or dying trees, ditches or hedges interfering with traffic, blocking footpaths, obscuring road signs or obscuring a view of the road ahead.

You are required to fell, cut, log, trim or remove such trees, ditches and hedges. Adequate signposting should be provided and the Council and Gardai notified before works commence.

Hedge cutting operations should, as far as possible, only be undertaken outside the critical nesting period of 1st March to 31st August.

Liability for damage or injury resulting from such hazards will rest with the landowner/ occupier.

**Section 75 of Roads Act 1993
Temporary Closing of Roads**

Wexford County Council has decided to close the road listed hereunder to vehicular traffic from Monday 4 March 2019 to Saturday 23 March 2019, to facilitate construction of the Clavass Roundabout on the Enniscorthy Bypass Scheme.

Road Closure: N80-1 from its junction with the Scarawalsh Roundabout to its junction with the L-6075 at Coolnahorna.

Alternative Route: From Scarawalsh Roundabout to Ferns to Tombrack to Ballyrankin to Clohamon to Ryland Lower via the N11, R745, L1020, L2006 and N80.

Alternative routes will be signposted. Local access will be facilitated.
