A wide variety of projects and schemes have been supported under the Fund in previous years, including community gardens and allotments, compost schemes, rainwater harvesting, biodiversity projects, waste reduction initiatives, educational initiatives and environmental exhibitions. **Section 75 of Roads Act 1993
Temporary Closing of Roads**

Notice is hereby given that Wexford County Council intends to close the road listed hereunder to vehicular traffic from Tuesday 17 September 2019 to Friday 4 October 2019, to facilitate construction of the New Ross Bypass Scheme.

Road Closure: L4026-1 at Stokestown from the Stokestown Port Roundabout to the Stokestown Under Bridge

Alternative Route: From Stokestown Port Roundabout to Camlin to Landscape to Oldcourt to Dunganstown to the Stokestown Under Bridge via the L4026, R733, L8050, L8052 and the L4026.

Alternative routes will be signposted. Local access will be facilitated.

Any person wishing to object to the closing of this road should lodge the objection, in writing, to the County Secretary, County Hall, Wexford, before 12.00 noon on Monday 2 September 2019.

Finance

Notice of consideration of setting a Local Adjustment Factor

The Finance (Local Property Tax) Act 2012 (as amended), makes specific provision that elected members of a local authority may pass a formal resolution to vary the basic rate of the Local Property Tax for their administrative area by a percentage known as the local adjustment factor. At the meeting set by Wexford County Council to consider this matter, the members may set a local adjustment factor within the range of +/- 15% of the basic rate, or, may decide not to adjust the basic rate.

Wexford County Council will meet in September to consider the setting of a local adjustment factor.

Wexford County Council welcomes written submissions from the public on this matter specifically covering the potential effects of varying the basic rate of the Local Property Tax on businesses, individuals and on local authority services.
