## Public Information Leaflet

Wexford County Council, acting on behalf of Kilkenny County Council and Waterford City and County Council, proposes the development of a Greenway from Rosslare Harbour to Waterford. The route is centred around the out of service Rosslare Strand to Waterford rail corridor that will connect to the South East Greenway at Drumdowney. The proposed project will provide:

- 57.5km of dedicated Greenway facility;
- A tourism and recreational amenity of regional significance;
- Opportunities for rural regeneration of towns and villages along the route

This project, in conjunction with the South East Greenway (New Ross to Waterford), will provide 82km of dedicated walking and cycling facilities in the South East of Ireland and provide Greenway connections for Rosslare Europort to New Ross, Waterford and beyond.



## Project Overview

The Rosslare to Waterford Greenway route is divided into 3 sections:

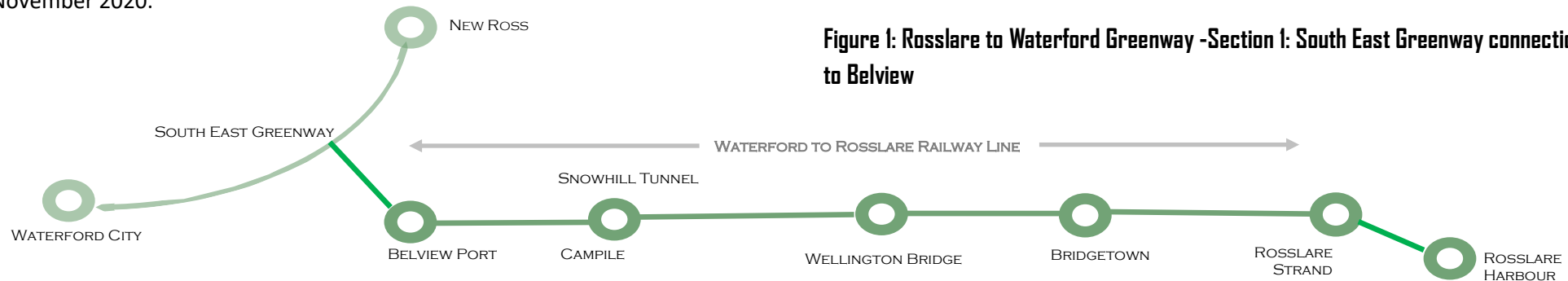
- Section 1: From the South East Greenway to Belview
- Section 2: Belview to Rosslare Strand
- Section 3: Rosslare Strand to Rosslare Harbour

The purpose of this information leaflet is to outline the proposed route for Section 1: South East Greenway connection to Belview and to engage with the local community and provide information on the proposed route. The rail line from Belview to Waterford is not available and an alternative route is required to connect to Co. Waterford.

The proposed route leaves the South East Greenway at approximately Point A on the Map at Drumdowney, crossing the L7482 local road, where it enters agricultural lands to the east. It then travels in a north / northeasterly direction within agricultural land where it will cross over the Drumdowney stream on a new bridge structure south of the existing bridge. The route would then travel in a south-easterly direction within agricultural lands until it joins up with the Rosslare to Waterford railway line at Point B on the map.

## Next Steps

We would like to hear from the local community of Belview and Drumdowney in relation to the proposed route and invite you to comment on the proposal. All feedback received for this project will be considered and incorporated into the application for planning consent to be submitted to An Bord Pleanála in November 2020.



## Map View

The proposed route of the Greenway from the South East Greenway to the out-of-service railway line at Belview is outlined on the below map (in red).

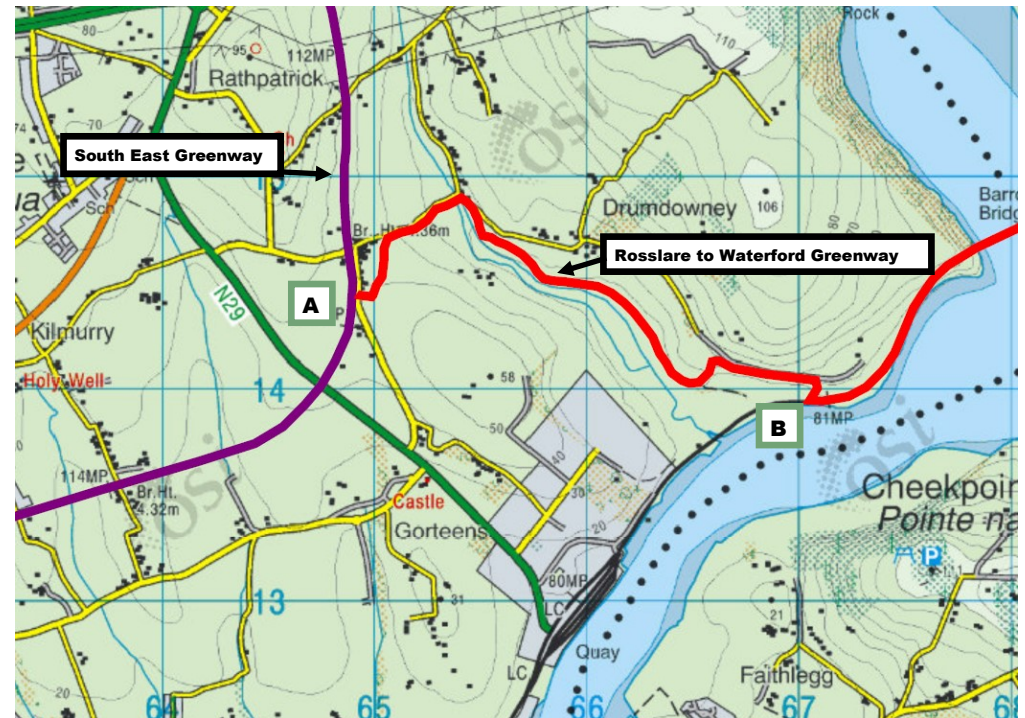


Figure 1: Rosslare to Waterford Greenway -Section 1: South East Greenway connection to Belview
