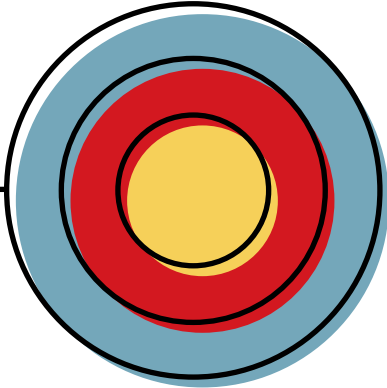

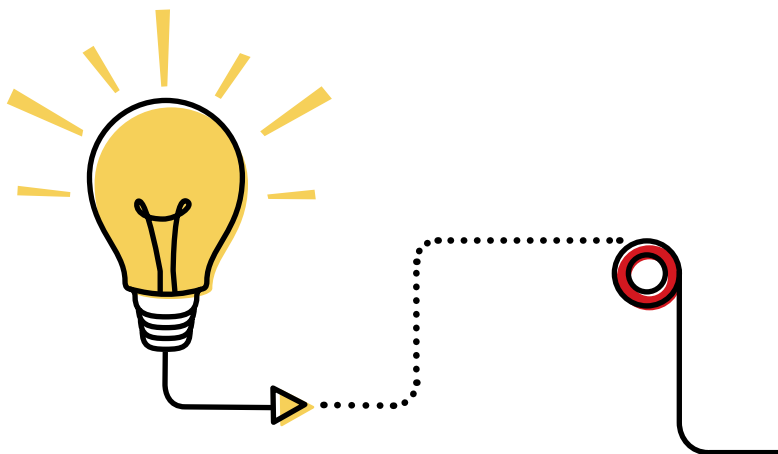

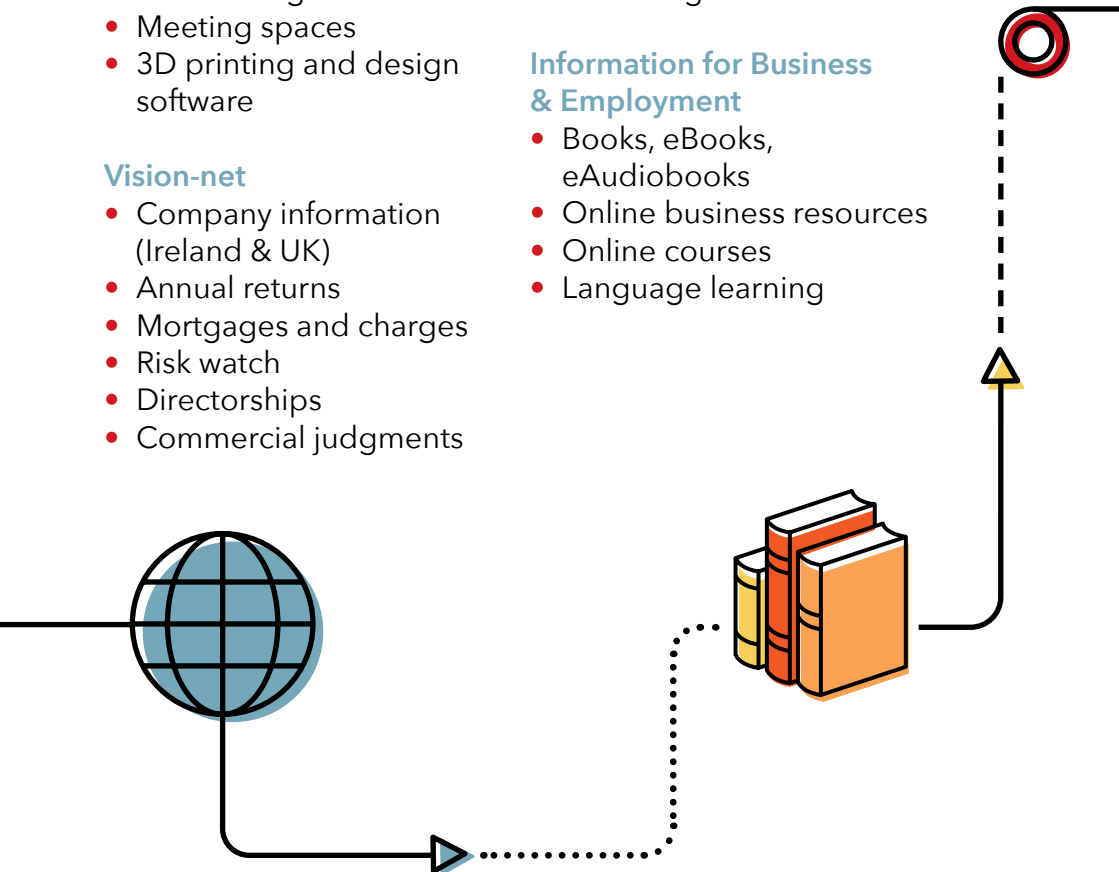

Introduction to Entrepreneurship and Lean Start-Up Principles

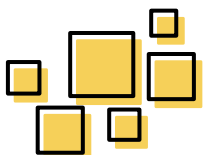
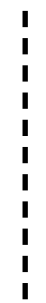

Participants are encouraged to attend all four sessions to get maximum benefit but it is possible to choose a session that suits. Each session will be approximately 30 to 60 minutes depending on Q&A and attendee feedback.

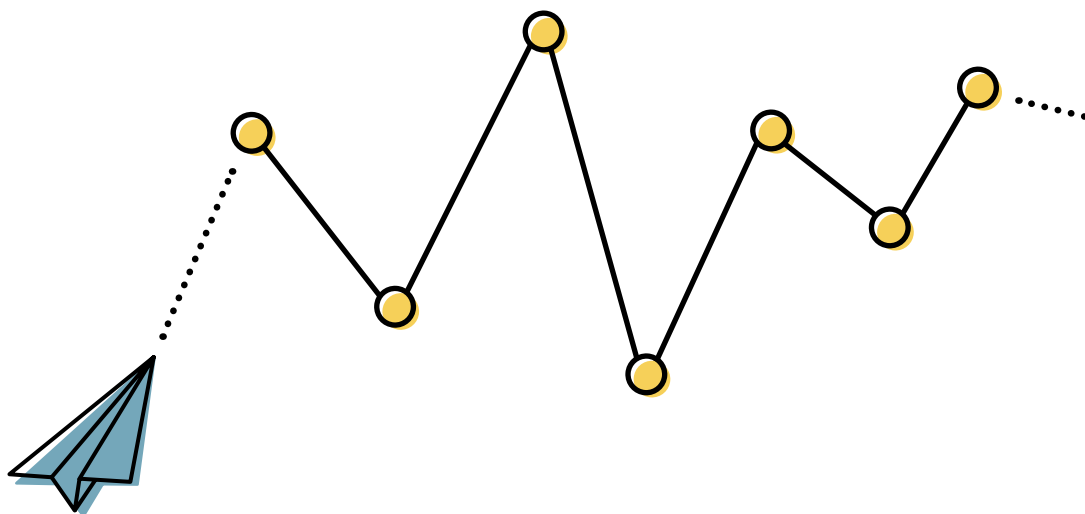

Build on the principles from week one and learn how to use other tools that will help you to understand your customer's needs and how you can add value to your offering.

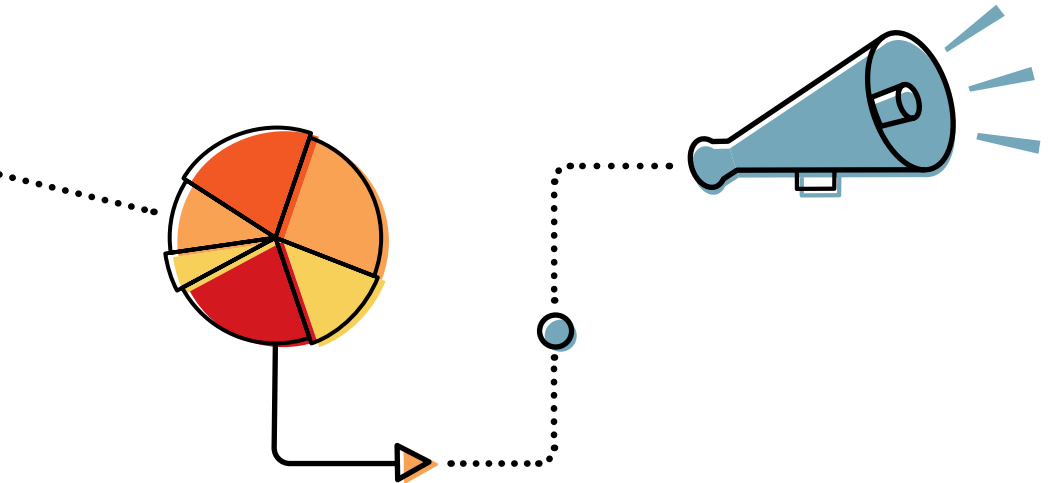

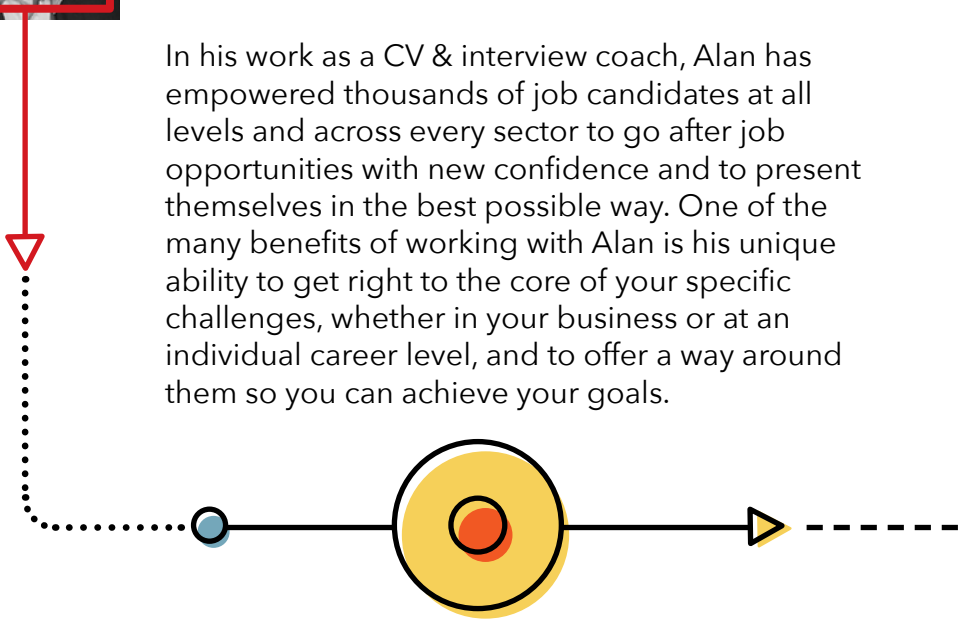

How to Complete an Effective CV, Cover Letter or Application Form

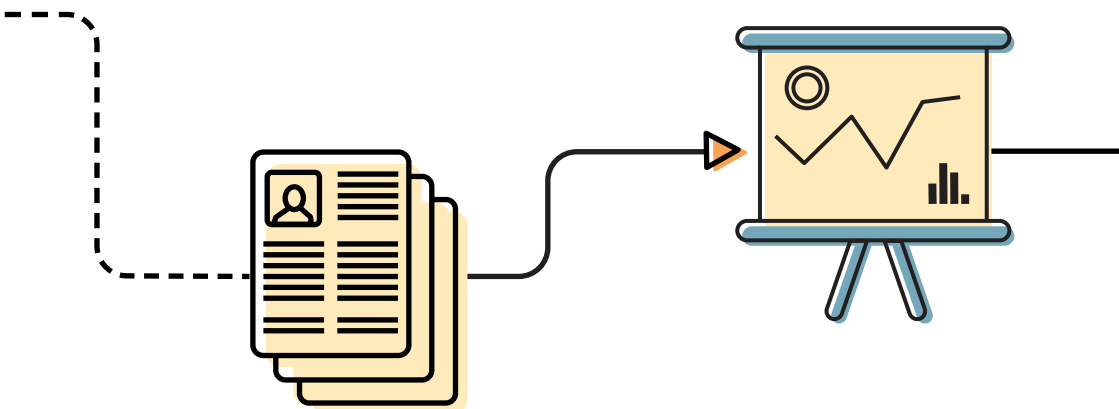

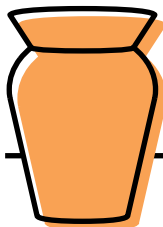
