





Impact of Road Connectivity on Employment Accessibility




Location of People employed in IT & Professional Services (27%)








Murphy Flood Site

Delivery Timeline for Trinity Wharf

Situated on the southern bank of the River Slaney and extending out into Wexford Harbour, **Trinity Wharf** is the fitting location for Wexford's newest modern, mixed-use commercial development in the heart of Wexford Town.

The Trinity Wharf master plan, designed by Ireland's leading architectural agency Scott Tallon Walker, incorporates three commercial office blocks, a 4-star hotel & 1,200 person capacity conference centre, residential units, marina, retail offering and multi-storey car park – all accommodated within an iconic and compact urban quarter which is bound by water on three sides with exquisite sea views.

Together, all of these individual components will be integrated with a network of attractive public realm infrastructure and amenities, carefully designed around a focal public realm plaza which will be capable of hosting open air performances and social / cultural events.

Trinity Wharf will be the epicentre for leisure, tourism and economic activity in Wexford Town, reaffirming Wexford as a destination to live and work, invest and visit.







TARA STUDIOS
