Wexford County Council Draft Waste Presentation Bye-Laws 2018

Draft Wexford County Council (Segregation, Storage and Presentation of Household and Commercial) Waste Bye-Laws 2018.

Wexford County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Part 19 and Section 199 of the Local Government Act 2001, as supplemented by Section 35 of the Waste Management Act 1996, hereby gives notice that it proposes to make new bye-laws to regulate and control the segregation, storage and presentation of household and commercial waste within its functional area.

It is proposed to make provision in the Bye-Laws for the imposition of a fixed penalty payment of €75 in respect of a contravention of a bye-law as an alternative to prosecution, as provided for in Section 206 of the Local Government Act 2001.

The Draft Bye-Laws will be available for public inspection from Tuesday 21st August 2018 to Friday 5th October 2018 during normal opening hours at Wexford County Council Offices at Carricklawn, Wexford and at all Municipal and Borough District Offices and on the Council's website www.wexfordcoco.ie/waste-and-recyling A copy of the Bye-Laws will be given to any such person requesting a copy, free of charge.
