SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT

BYE-LAWS 2008

MADE UNDER THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 2004







July 2008

WEXFORD COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (No. 44 of 2004), and with the consent of the National Roads Authority, hereby makes the following bye-laws in respect of the area comprising the administrative County of Wexford.

- 1. These bye-laws may be cited as the County Wexford Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws 2008
- 2. These bye-laws shall come into operation on the 1st day of September 2008.
- In these bye-laws:
 "the Act of 1961" means the Road Traffic Act, 1961 (No. 24 of 1961);
 "the Act of 1993" means the Roads Act, 1993 (No. 14 of 1993);
 "the Act of 2004" means the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (No. 44 of 2004);
 "distance" means distance measured along the centre line of the road;
 "the Minister means the Minister for Transport;
 "national road" has the meaning assigned to it by the Roads Act of 1993;
 "perimeter road" means a road on and along the roadway of which there runs the boundary of a county borough, a borough, or a town and shall be considered as being within such boundary for the purposes of these bye-laws;
 "road" means a public road.
- 4. Each of the roads described in the First Schedule to these bye-laws is subject to the special speed limit of 50 kilometres per hour.
- 5. Each of the roads described in the Second Schedule to these bye-laws is subject to the special speed limit of 60 kilometres per hour.
- 6. Each of the roads described in the Third Schedule to these bye-laws is subject to the special speed limit of 80 kilometres per hour.
- 7. Each of the roads described in the Fourth Schedule to these bye-laws is subject to the special speed limit of 100 kilometres per hour.
- 8. Exceptions:- There shall be excepted from the special speed limits prescribed in Articles 4, 5, 6 and 7 of these bye-laws the following:-
 - (a) ambulances;
 - (b) fire brigade vehicles; and

(c) vehicles used by members of An Garda Siochana in the performance of their duties as such members.

- 9. The County Wexford Speed Limit Bye-Laws 2004 are hereby revoked.
- 10. The County Wexford Speed Limit Bye-Laws 2006 are hereby revoked.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Roads in respect of which a special speed limit of 50 kilometres per hour is prescribed

- 1. The following roads at Askamore:-
 - (a) The Brideswell-Ballytarsna Road between a point 350 metres north-east of its junction with the Slieveboy Road and a point 175 metres north-west of said junction.
 - (b) The Slieveboy Road for a distance of 50 metres from its junction with the Brideswell -Ballytarsna Road.
- 2. The following roads at Ballycanew:-
 - (a) The Wexford Gorey Road (R741) between a point 145 metres south-west of its junction with the Ballymore Road and a point 40 metres north of its junction with the Village Gate Road.
 - (b) The Ballymore Road for a distance of 410 metres from its junction with the Wexford Gorey Road (R741).
 - (c) The Killenagh Road for a distance of 213 metres from its junction with the Wexford Gorey Road (R741) and including the slip road (by the Old Mill) between the Killenagh Road and the Wexford Gorey Road (R741).
 - (d) The roads in Ounavarra Park and Old Ballycanew Housing Estate.

3. <u>The following roads at Ballyduff:-</u>

- (a) The Ferns-Craanford Road between a point 60 metres south of its junction with the Camolin Road and a point 485 metres north east of said junction.
- (b) The Camolin Road for a distance of 60 metres from its junction with the Ferns-Craanford Road.
- 4. <u>The following roads at Ballyfad:-</u>
 - (a) The Coolgreany-Pallis Road between a point 65 metres east of its junction with the Croghan Road and a point 190 metres south-west of said junction.
 - (b) The Croghan Road for a distance of 158 metres from its junction with the Coolgreany-Pallis Road.

5. <u>The following roads at Ballygarrett:-</u>

- (a) The Courtown-Kilmuckridge Road (R742) between a point 500 metres north of its junction with the Cahore Road and a point 390 metres south of said junction.
- (b) The Cahore Road for a distance of 232 metres from its junction with the Courtown-Kilmuckridge Road (R742).

(c) The Ballyoughna Road for a distance of 250 metres from its junction with the Courtown-Kilmuckridge Road (R742).

6. <u>The following roads at Ballymoney:-</u>

- (a) The Clonatin Road for a distance of 270 metres from its junction with the Beach Road
- (b) The Courtown Road for a distance 265 metres from its junction with Beach Road.
- (c) The Beach Road from its junction with Clonatin-Courtown Road to its terminal point at the Coast.
- (d) The Ballycomelone Road for a distance of 95 metres from its junction with the Clonatin Road.
- (e) The Kildermot Road for a distance of 75 metres from its junction with the Clonatin Road.

7. The following roads at Boleyvogue:-

- (a) The Harrow-Ballyedmond Road between a point 545 metres north-west of its junction with the Ballytracey Road and a point 12 metres south-east of its junction with the Ballyorley Road.
- (b) The Ballyorley Road for a distance of 50 metres from its junction with The Harrow-Ballyedmond Road.
- (c) The Ballytracey Road for a distance of 68 metres from its junction with The Harrow-Ballyedmond Road.
- (d) The roads in Sunset Drive.

8. The following roads at Cahore:-

- (a) The Ballygarrett-Seaview Road between a point 300 metres north-west of its junction with the Pier Road and a point 535 metres south-west of its junction with local road to Cahore House.
- (b) The Pier Road between its junction with the Ballygarrett-Seaview Road and the slipway at the Pier.
- (c) The local road at Cahore between its junction with the Ballygarrett-Seaview Road and its terminal point at the entrance to Cahore House.

9. The following roads at Camolin:-

- (a) The Gorey-Ferns Road (National Road N11) between a point 275 metres southwest of its junction with the Railway Road and a point 425 metres north-east of its junction with Limerick Lane.
- (b) Limerick Lane for a distance of 315 metres from its junction with the Gorey Ferns Road (National Road N11).

- (c) The Ballyduff Road for a distance of 92 metres from its junction with the Gorey-Ferns Road (National Road N11).
- (d) The Railway Road for a distance of 142 metres from its junction with the Gorey-Enniscorthy Road (National Road N11).

10. The following road at Castletown:-

The main road in Castletown Village between a point 295 metres north-west of its junction with the Kilcavan/Cloneranny Road (Coast Road) and a point 835 metres north-west of said junction.

11. The following roads at Coolgreany:-

- (a) The Inch-Ballykilty Road between a point 335 metres south-west of its junction with the Ballyfad Road and a point 245 metres north-east of said junction
- (b) The Ballyfad Road for a distance of 225 metres from its junction with the Inch-Ballykilty Road.
- (c) The Long Lane or Ballylarkin Road for a distance of 210 metres from its junction with the Inch-Ballykilty Road.
- (d) The roads in Croghan View.

12. The following roads at Courtown, Riverchapel, Ardamine and Pollshone:-

All roads in the area enclosed by a line commencing at the point on the eastern edge of the Burrow Road where the said road terminates at the footbridge over the Owenavorragh River and thence in a straight line successively to the following points:

- (a) the seaward terminal point of the south pier, Courtown Harbour,
- (b) a point at the seaward terminal point of the Pollshone Road,
- (c) a point on the Courtown-Kilmuckridge Road (R742) 80 metres south of its junction with the Pollshone Road,
- (d) a point on the Middletown Road 855 metres south-west of its junction with the Courtown-Kilmuckridge Road (R742),
- (e) a point on the Gorey-Courtown Road (R742) 45 metres west of its junction with the Red Row,
- (f) a point at the western edge of the Burrow Road where that road terminates at the footbridge over the Owenavorragh River

and from that point in a straight line to the commencement point on the eastern edge of the said road.

13. The following roads at Craanford:-

(a) The Craanford-Camolin Road between a point 355 metres north-east of its junction with the Clonamona Lane and a point 70 metres south-west of its junction with the Gorey-Carnew Road (R725).

(b) The Slip Road at Craanford from its junction with the Craanford-Camolin Road to a point 110 metres south-east of its junction with the Gorey-Carnew Road (R725).

14. The following roads at Ferns:-

All roads (other than the roads set out at reference 7 in the Second Schedule to these Bye-Laws) in the area enclosed by a line commencing at a point on the Gorey-Enniscorthy Road (National Road N11) 110 metres north-east of its junction with the Askamore Road and thence in a straight line successively to the following points:

- (a) a point on the Station Road 270 metres east of its junction with the Killoggy Road.
- (b) a point on the Killoggy Road 375 metres north of its junction with the crossroads at Doran's Bridge,
- (c) a point on the Gorey-Enniscorthy Road (National Road N11) 208 metres southwest of the western boundary of Ferns Cemetery,
- (d) a point on the Bunclody Road (R745) 370 metres east of its junction with the Tombrack Road,
- (e) a point on the Newtown Road 455 metres north-west of its junction with the Bunclody Road (R745),

and from that point in a straight line to the commencement point on the Gorey-Enniscorthy Road (National Road N11).

15. The following roads adjacent to and near the Town of Gorey:-

- (a) The Arklow Road (R772) between the Gorey Town Boundary and a point 240 metres north-east of its junction with the Coach Road.
- (b) The Garden City Road between the Gorey Town Boundary and its junction with the Knockina Road.
- (c) The Clonatin Road for a distance of 830 metres north-east of the point where the Gorey Town Boundary intersects the northern side of the road, including all roads in Clonatin Estate, Fox Hill, Hillcrest View, Oak Ridge, Twin Oaks and Doire Fea.
- (d) The Carnew Road (R725) from the Gorey Town Boundary to a point 25 metres south-west of its junction with Kilnahue Lane, and including all roads in the Forde Estate and Westhill Park.
- (e) The Knockina Road between its junction with the Arklow Road (R772) and a point 120 metres north of its junction with the Ramsfortpark-Ballyteganpark Road.
- (f) Kilnahue Lane from its junction with the Carnew Road (R725) and a point 305 metres north-west of said junction.
- (g) The Creagh Road for a distance of 220 metres north-west of the point where the Gorey Town Boundary intersects the south western side of the road.

- (h) The Ramsfortpark-Ballyteganpark Road (including its cul-de-sac northwestwards) between its junction with the Knockina Road and the Gorey Town Boundary at Ramsfortpark Road.
- (i) The connecting road between the Fort Road and the Ramsfortpark-Ballyteganpark Road including the roads in Willow Park and Ashwood Grove.
- (j) The roads in Ramsfort Avenue, Park Avenue and Allenwood Drive.
- (k) The Coach Road from its junction with the Arklow Road (R772) to the Gorey Town Boundary.
- (I) The Courtown Road (R742) for a distance of 250 metres from the Gorey Town Boundary.
- (m) The Mill Road for a distance of 145 metres from the Gorey Town Boundary.
- (n) The Hollyfort Road for a distance of 7 metres north-west of the point where the Gorey Town Boundary intersects the western side of the road.
- (o) The Ballycanew Road (R741) for a distance of 155 metres south-east of the point where the Gorey Town Boundary intersects the western side of the road.
- (p) The roads in The Gallops and The Sidings at Ballycanew Road (R741).
- (q) The Ramstown Road for a distance of 445 metres south-west of the point where the Gorey Town Boundary intersects the western side of the road.

16. The following roads at The Harrow:-

- (a) The Ferns-Ballyedmond Road between a point 78 metres north-west of its junction with the Tinnacross Road and a point 164 metres south-east of its junction with the Ballymore Road.
- (b) The Ballymore Road for a distance of 71 metres from its junction with the Ballyedmond Road
- (c) The Tinnacross Road for a distance of 95 metres from its junction with the Ferns Road.

17. The following roads at Hollyfort:-

- (a) The Tinahealy-Gorey Road between a point 130 metres north-west of its junction with the Killinierin Road and a point 415 metres south-east of said junction.
- (b) The Killinierin Road for a distance of 190 metres from its junction with the Tinahealy-Gorey Road.
- (c) The Monaseed Road for a distance of 900 metres from of its junction with the Tinahealy-Gorey Road.

18. The following roads at Killinierin:-

- (a) The Main Street and its continuation as the Tinnock Road between a point 267 metres south-east of its junction with the Pond Road or Lackan Road and a point 205 metres north-west of said junction.
- (b) The Pond Road or Lackan Road for a distance of 86 metres from its junction with the Main Street.
- (c) The Borleagh Road for a distance of 131 metres from its junction with the Main Street.

19. The following roads at Kilmuckridge:-

- (a) The Courtown-Blackwater Road (R742) between a point 660 metres north-east of the centre line of the bridge in Kilmuckridge Village and a point 565 metres south-west of its junction with the Killincooley Road.
- (b) The Kilnamanagh Road for a distance of 570 metres from its junction with the Courtown-Blackwater Road (R742).
- (c) The Morriscastle Road for a distance of 87 metres from its junction with the Courtown-Blackwater Road (R742).
- (d) The Killincooly Road for a distance of 315 metres from its junction with the Courtown-Blackwater Road (R742).
- (e) The roads in Greenwood Avenue and Grotto Close.

20. The following roads at Monaseed:-

- (a) The Foxcover-Annagh Road between a point 390 metres west of its junction with the Chapel Road and a point 195 metres north east of said junction.
- (b) The Chapel Road for a distance of 1060 metres south of its junction with the Foxcover-Annagh Road.

End of Schedule

SECOND SCHEDULE

Roads in respect of which a special speed limit of 60 kilometres per hour is prescribed.

1. The following roads at Ballyedmond:-

- (a) The Wexford-Gorey Road (R741) between a point 175 metres south-west of its junction with The Harrow Road and a point 610 metres north-east of said junction.
- (b) The Harrow Road for a distance of 75 metres from its junction with the Wexford-Gorey Road (R741).
- (c) The Boira Road for a distance of 160 metres from its junction with the Wexford-Gorey Road (R741).

2. <u>The following road at Ballymoney:-</u>

The Courtown Road between a point 265 metres south of its junction with Beach Road and a point 130 metres south of entrance into Seafield Golf Centre.

3. <u>The following roads at Clogh:-</u>

- (a) The Enniscorthy-Gorey Road (R772) between a point 110 metres south-west of its junction with the Balloughter Road and a point 283 metres north-east of said junction.
- (b) The Balloughter Road for a distance of 70 metres from its junction with the Enniscorthy-Gorey Road (R772).
- (c) The Barnadown Road for a distance of 30 metres from its junction with the Balloughter Road.

4. <u>The following roads at Coolgreany:-</u>

- (a) The Inch Road between a point 235 metres south-east of its junction with the Gorteen Road and a point 335 metres south-west of its junction with the Ballyfad Road.
- (b) The Ballyfad Road between a point 45 metres south-east of its junction the Newtown Road and a point 225 metres north-west of its junction with the Inch-Ballykilty Road.
- (c) The Gorteen Road for a distance of 300 metres from its junction with the Inch Road.

5. <u>The following roads at Courtown:-</u>

(a) The Gorey-Courtown Road (R742) between a point 45 metres west of its junction with the Red Row and a point 45 metres north-west of its junction with the Ballymoney Road.

- (b) The Ballymoney Road for a distance of 50 metres from its junction with the Gorey-Courtown Road (R742).
- (c) The Owenavorragh Road for a distance of 50 metres from its junction with the Gorey-Courtown Road (R742).

6. The following roads at Craanford:-

- (a) The Gorey-Carnew Road (R725) between a point 110 metres north west of its junction with the Craanford Road and a point 195 metres south east of said junction.
- (b) The Craanford Road for a distance of 70 metres from its junction with the Gorey-Carnew Road (R725)
- (c) The Hollyfort Road for a distance of 50 metres from its junction with the Gorey-Carnew Road (R725)

7. The following roads at Ferns:-

- (a) The Gorey Road (National Road N11) between a point 245 metres north-east of its junction with the Station Road and a point 110 metres north-east of its junction with the Askamore Road.
- (b) The Enniscorthy Road (National Road N11) between a point 23 metres northeast of the western wall of Ferns Cemetery and a point 208 metres south-west of said boundary wall.
- (c) The Bunclody Road (R745) between a point 370 metres east of its junction with the Tombrack Road and a point 207 metres west of its junction with the Coolbaun Slip Road at the Monument.
- (d) The Askamore Road for a distance of 70 metres from its junction with the Gorey Road (National Road N11)

8. The following roads in, adjacent to and near the Town of Gorey:-

- (a) The Enniscorthy Road (R772) between a point 50 metres south-west of its junction with the Ramstown Road and a point 75 metres south-west of the Gorey Town Boundary.
- (b) The Arklow Road (R772) between a point 240 metres north-east of its junction with the Coach Road and a point 492 metres north-east of said junction.
- (c) The Carnew Road (R725) between a point 25 metres south-west of its junction with Kilnahue Lane and a point 610 metres south west of said junction
- (d) The Ballycanew Road (R741) between a point 155 metres south-east of the point where the Gorey Town Boundary intersects the western side of the road and a point 473 metres south-east of said boundary.
- (e) The Hollyfort Road between a point 7 metres north-west of the point where the Gorey Town Boundary intersects the western side of the road and a point 360 metres north-west of said boundary.

9. The following roads at Inch:-

- (a) The Gorey-Arklow Road (R772) between a point 250 metres north-east of its junction with the Coolgreany Road and a point 260 metres south-west of its junction with the Coolnagloose Road.
- (b) The Coolgreany Road for a distance of 180 metres from its junction with the Gorey-Arklow Road (R772).
- (c) The Coolnagloose Road for a distance of 80 metres from its junction with the Gorey-Arklow Road (R772).
- (d) The Perrymount Road for a distance of 135 metres from its junction with the Gorey-Arklow Road (R772).

End of Schedule

THIRD SCHEDULE

Roads in respect of which a special speed limit of 80 kilometres per hour is prescribed.

 - (c) The roads in Glentire Heights.

2. <u>The following roads at Ballindaggan:-</u>

- (a) The Kiltealy-Ferns Road (R745) between a point 255 metres west of its junction with the Coolycarney Road and a point 300 metres east of said junction.
- (b) The Coolycarney Road for a distance of 265 metres south-west of its junction with the Kiltealy-Ferns Road (R745).
- (c) The Templeshanbo Road for a distance of 385 metres from its junction with the Kiltealy-Ferns Road (R745).
- (d) The School Road for a distance of 315 metres from its junction with the Coolycarney Road.
- (e) The Curraghgraigue Road for a distance of 90 metres from its junction with the School Road.

3. The following roads at Ballyhoge:-

- (a) The Enniscorthy-Killurin Road between a point 235 metres north of its junction with the Galbally Road and a point230 metres south of said junction.
- (b) The Galbally Road for a distance of 770 metres from its junction with the Enniscorthy-Killurin Road.
- (c) The Bellvue Road for a distance of 120 metres from its junction with the Enniscorthy-Killurin Road.

4. <u>The following roads at Ballymurn:-</u>

- (a) The Enniscorthy-Curracloe Road between a point 250 metres north-west of its junction with the Oilgate Road and a point 228 metres south-east of said junction.
- (b) The Oilgate Road for a distance of 135 metres from its junction with the Enniscorthy-Curracloe Road.

(c) The Ballina Upper Road for a distance of 350 metres from its junction with the Enniscorthy-Curracloe Road.

5. <u>The following roads at Blackwater:-</u>

- (a) The Curracloe-Courtown Harbour Road (R742) between a point 364 metres north-east of its junction with the Beach Road and a point 364 metres southwest of its junction with the Enniscorthy Road (R744).
- (b) The Enniscorthy Road (R744) for a distance of 625 metres from its junction with the Curracloe-Courtown Harbour Road (R742).
- (c) The Beach Road from its junction with the Curracloe-Courtown Harbour Road (R742) to its terminal point at the Coast.
- (d) Inch Lane for a distance of 250 metres from its junction with the Curracloe-Courtown Harbour Road (R742).

6. <u>The following roads at Bree:-</u>

- (a) The Knocknagross-Clough Road between a point 540 metres north of its junction with Bree Lane and a point 330 metres south of said junction.
- (b) Bree Lane for a distance of 100 metres from its junction with the Knocknagross-Clough Road.

7. The following roads at Bunclody:-

- (a) The Bunclody-Enniscorthy Road (National Road N80) between a point 75 metres north-west of its junction with Church Street at Clody Bridge (County Boundary with County Carlow) and a point 450 metres south-east of its junction with Irish Street, including Carrickduff Road (part of), The Mall, Ryland Street and Ryland Road (part of).
- (b) Irish Street and its continuation as the Kiltealy Road (R746) between its junction with Ryland Street (National Road N80) and a point 53 metres south-east of its junction with Hospital Hill.
- (c) Church Street and its continuation as the Mill Road for a distance of 770 metres from its junction with The Mall (National Road N80).
- (d) The Carnew Road (R746) for a distance of 575 metres north-east of its junction with Ryland Street (National Road N80).
- (e) Hospital Hill between its junction with the Kiltealy Road (R746) and a point 220 metres south-west of its junction with Ard Colm.
- (f) Chapel Lane, Market Square and St. Mary's Villas.

8. <u>The following roads at Castledockrell:-</u>

(a) The Ballindaggan-Mountfin Road between a point 390 metres west of its junction with the Tombrick Road and a point 230 metres east of said junction.

- (b) The Tombrick Road for a distance of 525 metres from its junction with the Ballindaggan-Mountfin Road.
- (c) The Tomanoole Road for a distance of 170 metres from its junction with the Ballindaggan-Mountfin Road.

9. <u>The following roads at Clohamon:-</u>

- (a) The Bunclody-Ferns Road between a point 83 metres north-east of its junction with the Bunclody-Enniscorthy Road (National Road N80) and a point 330 metres south-east of its junction with the School Road.
- (b) The School Road for a distance of 925 metres from its junction with the Bunclody-Ferns Road.
- (c) The Graigue More Road for a distance of 95 metres from its junction with the School Road.

10. The following roads at Courtnacuddy:-

- (a) The Courtnacuddy-Rathfylane Road between a point 240 metres west of its junction with Chapel Lane and a point 225 metres south-east of said junction.
- (b) Chapel Lane for a distance of 160 metres from its junction with the Courtnacuddy-Rathfylane Road.

11. The following roads at Davidstown:-

- (a) The Coolamurray-Ballygillistown Road between a point 440 metres northwest of its junction with Cloney Park and a point 195 metres east of said junction.
- (b) The roads in Cloney Park.

12. The following roads adjacent to and near the Town of Enniscorthy:-

- (a) The Blackstoops Road (National Road N11) between the point where the Enniscorthy Town boundary intersects the north-western side of the road and a point 305 metres north-east of said point.
- (b) The Kiltealy Road (R702) between the point where the Enniscorthy Town boundary intersects the north-eastern side of the road and a point 7 metres north-west of the centre point of the Bloody Bridge.
- (c) Munster Hill between its junction with the Enniscorthy-New Ross Road (National Road N30) and the point where the Enniscorthy Town boundary intersects the eastern side of the road.
- (d) The Oulart Road (R744) between the Enniscorthy Town boundary and a point 40 metres south-east of its junction with Rectory Heights.
- (e) The Solsborough Road for a distance of 66 metres north-east of its junction with the Oulart Road (R744).

- (f) The Old Church Road and its continuation as Rectory Road between the Enniscorthy Town boundary and its junction with the Oulart Road (R744).
- (g) The Esmonde Road between the Enniscorthy Town boundary and a point 64 metres west of its junction with the Aughnagalley Road.
- (h) The part of the Spring Valley Road which lies outside the Enniscorthy Town boundary.
- (i) The Nunnery Road (R889) between the point where the Enniscorthy Town boundary intersects the south-eastern side of the road and a point 140 metres north-east of said point.
- (j) The Killagoley Road between its intersection with the Esmonde Road and a point 340 metres south-west of said junction.
- (k) The Drumgold Road between the point where the Enniscorthy Town boundary intersects the north-eastern side of the road and a point 50 metres west of its intersection with Vinegar Hill Lane.

Explanatory Note:-

(This note is not part of the instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

These Bye-Laws replace the County Wexford Speed Limit Bye-Laws 2004 and the County Wexford Speed Limit Bye-Laws 2006. The Bye-Laws create new special speed limits in certain areas and alter the speed limits in other areas.

The Bye-Laws prescribe a special speed limit of 50 kilometres per hour in respect of the public roads mentioned in the First Schedule.

The Bye-Laws prescribe a special speed limit of 60 kilometres per hour in respect of the public roads mentioned in the Second Schedule.

The Bye-Laws prescribe a special speed limit of 80 kilometres per hour in respect of the public roads mentioned in the Third Schedule.

The Bye-Laws prescribe a special speed limit of 100 kilometres per hour in respect of the public roads mentioned in the Fourth Schedule.

Ambulances, fire brigade vehicles and Garda Siochana vehicles while being used in the course of duty are excepted from all speed limits by the Bye-Laws.
