

Dear Sir or Madam,

I would like to make comment on the Further Information Response from Wexford County Council submitted to the Bord on the 14th October 2019.

On page 55 of the Further Information Response there are comments from WCC regarding my concerns raised in my original submission of the 31st March 2019. I welcome the response in relation to the introduction of herring bone parking in front of the Green Area to Fishers Row but as mentioned in my original submission, in the original Planning Application, regarding the above proposed development, there is a provision for a turning head on Seaview Avenue and upon meeting with representatives of Wexford County Council on site, the residents proposed the provision of designated parking along with the turning head to alleviate the immediate loss of parking to residents, with herringbone parking proceeding south along Trinity Street up to Fishers Row, in front of the green area. This would diminish some of the existing green area and a representative of the residents of Fishers Row who cares for the green area, agreed with this suggestion. I would be obliged if the Bord could take this into consideration as well as the herring bone parking proposal when considering their final decision on this matter.
