


Trail Details

Located beside the Marina directly off the R723 alongside the River Barrow and opposite the town park, this walkway is a fully accessible trail alongside the banks of the River Barrow. This linear trail begins at New Ross Marina and extends to the Oaklands roundabout. The area is naturally beautiful and steeped in history. Public lighting and seating along the route allow people to sit and enjoy the river and its activities, wildlife and nature well into the late evenings. Parking ,including accessible parking space, is located directly at the entrance to the trail. Toilets and an accessible WC are available at Pearse Park and also at the Dunbrody Visitor Centre.



Parking & Approach

This trail consists of a multi-user surface of tarmacadam with a width of 2 metres. There is a ramped entrance to a level linear walkway which travels along the banks of the River Barrow. Parking including accessible designated blue badge parking is located directly at the entrance in the shadow of an impressive sculpture. Public lighting along the route support ease of access for all visitors both day and night.



Seating

The route throughout is dotted with seating that have backs and armrests for extra support for visitors.



Artwork & Signage

Artwork, signage and arrangements located along the trail invite visitors to stop and take time to enjoy the stunning photographs and learn of the history of the area.
