

Special Meeting. 18 March 1908.

A Special meeting of the Wexford County Council, was held in the Council Chamber Courthouse, Wexford, on 18<sup>th</sup> March 1908, for the purpose of executing two mortgages to the National Bank for loans obtained to extinguish existing loans from the Board of Works.

Present:- Sir T. H. G. Esmonde, Bart. M.P., Chairman, Presiding. Other members. Messrs M. A. Ennis Vice-Chairman, Michael Browne, C. Store, James Codd, N. C. Murphy, John Sinnott, James Donohoe, M. Doyle, John J. Kehoe, and J. C. Mayler.

The Secretary, and Mr R. W. Selger were in attendance. On the motion of Mr Ennis, seconded by Mr Sinnott the following resolution was adopted:-

Resolved:- "That the sums of £3950.9.4, and £1014.4.5  
"recently paid off by the Council to the Board of  
"Works, Ireland being the sums representing respectively  
"the balances due to the said Board by the Council  
"in respect of the loans formerly made to the late  
"Grand Jury of this County in connection with the  
"extending and improving of the Harbour of Arklow,  
"and the repair, and improvement of the Mountgarrett  
"Bridge respectively, shall be raised by the Council  
"by re. borrowing the same from the National Bank  
"Limited upon mortgage of that portion of the County  
"fund and of the rates, dues, and taxes, and revenues  
"of the Council as may be legally available in  
"that behalf, the said sums respectively to be charged  
"upon the said Funds and Revenues, together with  
"interest thereon respectively at the rate of £3 per  
"cent per annum, in favour of the said Bank.  
"And that the said loan to be made by the said  
"Bank, be repaid by equal annual instalments  
"in the case of the said loan of £3950.9.4, of the  
"sum of £226.17.3, and in the case of the said loan  
"of £1014.4.5, of the sum of £118.13.0."

Proposed by Mr M. A. Ennis, seconded by Mr John Sinnott and adopted:- Resolved:- "That the Seal of the County  
"Council be affixed to mortgages in the above men-  
"tioned Resolution specified to the National Bank  
"to secure the repayment of the above-mentioned sums

Fara Hills Quarry.

On the motion of Mr. Bunnis, seconded by Mr. Sinnott the following resolution was adopted:— "That the seal of the County Council be also affixed to the lease from Lord Courtown to the County Council of the plot of ground on Fara Hill."
